Criteria

Awarded to a full-time graduate student (in year two through four, currently) working in the area of Physical Geography based on financial need and academic achievement (minimum 78% average) in the previous academic year. **Applicants cannot hold a major external scholarship.** Recipients will be chosen in the spring after the Tri-Council/OGS awards are announced. The recipient will be selected by the Department of Geography.

This award is offered through the Ontario Student Opportunity Trust Fund (OSOTF) program, and recipients must meet Ontario residency requirements.

Submit this form, along with an update CV, to the Graduate Administrator. Your transcript will be attached on your behalf.
