### Criteria

To be eligible, a student must be in Years 2 to 4 of the PhD program and be undertaking research on some cultural process or cultural phenomena's spatial impact on the human environment. A committee in the Department of Geography, with at least one representative who is a current member of the School of Graduate and Postdoctoral Studies, will select the recipient. This award was established through Foundation Western.
